

Network Node Right-of-Way Permit Application

STANDARDS FOR CONSTRUCTION IN PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY & EASEMENTS As required by City of Grand Prairie Ordinance # 7174

This Form Must Be Filled Out Completely with All Required Signatures

- Each location is required to have ON SITE a copy of this Permit, the City Ordinance (#7174), and a copy of the City released Traffic Control Plan.
- Notification must be given to the City of Grand Prairie Engineering Inspection Division, 300 W. Main Street, prior to commencement of any work.
- Contractor is responsible for contacting utility owners/agents to locate underground services per plans; for City water/sewer/signal/fiber locates call 972-237-8413 (requires 72 hour notice). Provide copy of confirmation of completed locates.
- A City released Traffic Control Plan shall be required for any lane closures and submitted with this notification. Contractor shall provide a copy of all TxDOT permits and/or State approved TCP to City staff.
- Barricades shall be furnished and maintained by the contractor and installation shall conform to City standards.
- City of Grand Prairie backfill standards must be met for ditch lines. Mechanical tamping is required for all ditch lines to achieve 95% Standard Proctor Density.
- 24 hour notifications shall be given prior to or boring streets. Open cutting of City streets is not allowed except by special consideration by the Director of Transportation.
- City of Grand Prairie standards shall be met for street and/or sidewalk repairs after utilities are installed. Streets shall be sawed at full depth as per City of Grand Prairie standards. Street and/or sidewalk cuts shall not be left open overnight unless approved by the Transportation Department. Safety devices must be in place until construction is completed.
- Bore pits shall be fenced in and shall not be left open for more than 48 hours, subject to City Inspector approval.
- Ditch lines shall remain open no longer than 48-hours and coordinated with the City Franchise Utility Inspector at 972-237-8141. J.
- Maintain minimum of 30" cover on all utilities as per City Ordinance, Chapter 23-23-1.
- Emergency Repairs should be reported within 48 hours of repair at 972-237-8141. L.
- Traffic Control and Safe work zone are the responsibility of the Utility Co. / Contractor.
- N Utility hereby agrees to hold the City of Grand Prairie harmless from any damages arising out of any claim in connection with this work.
- 0. All safety measures shall be followed as required by OSHA Standards.
- Release is contingent on approval of third-party structure owner for location. Provide documentation prior to starting construction. P.
- Permit shall expire after a period of one (1) year from the date of release of the permit. Expiration shall require a new permit submittal with fee. Due to storage limitations, the City will not retain expired applications.
- Rental fees will begin to accrue 3 months after the permit is released by the City. The first rental fee will be pro-rated based on the number of months remaining in the calendar year and subsequent fees will be invoiced based on a traditional calendar year (Jan 1 – Dec 31). Rent is \$250 annually.
- The fee for each submitted Node ROW Permit Application is \$500.00 (this fee applies to the first 1 to 5 node ROW requests. Fee for each additional node request is \$250 (City-owned pole) and \$100 (non-City-owned pole)
